Dear Parent/Carer,

As we move ever closer to the opening of our new school and the historical closure of the old building I wanted to give you all an update on some changes to school dates to ensure that we can move smoothly, safely and effectively into the new build.

The school term will now close for students in Years 7 to 10 on Tuesday 16th July to allow staff to pack equipment and resources ready to be moved over the summer holidays. The old school will then close to all staff and students on Friday 19th July where large boards will be constructed around the old site to create a demolition site. The new school will be officially handed over to E-ACT on Thursday 1st August 2019.

For Year 11 students who will collect their exam results on Thursday August 22nd this will take place in the new school, more details will be provided nearer the time.

The new school academic year starts with two inset days on Monday 2nd September and Tuesday 3rd September 2019 where staff will be trained in all aspects of the new building and another day on Wednesday 4th September to unpack and get ready for our returning students.
