As we move into the final year at Royton and Crompton Academy for our Year 10 students, I am writing to inform all parents/carers that the Year 10 cohort will be sitting their end of year exams in the next coming weeks. The exam timetable is on the reverse side of this letter. As you will see, the exams will run over a 2-week period, starting from Monday 17th June- Friday 28th June. These exams play a significant part in your child's progress within school, the results will help structure their timetables for the new academic year in regards to: settings, tiered papers and mentoring groups. It will also give staff a realistic benchmark of their overall performance.
