



My child has difficulties with cognition and learning needs

This can include:

- Reading and Spelling
- Learning new information and concepts
- Working with numbers
- Working memory
- Concentration
- Understanding of language
- Students may have conditions such as Specific Learning Difficulties, dyslexia, general learning difficulties, AD(H)D, ASD
- Students may present with difficulties that do not have a specific title

- Access to homework clubs
